## **SCOPE OF THE SYMPOSIUM**

The symposium aims to present recent research advances and new strategies for managing **broomrape** (*Orobanche cumana* Wallr.), a major global challenge in sunflower production.

For the first time, the Symposium will also address both biotic and abiotic challenges, recognizing the growing complexity of multiple diseases, pests, drought, and soil degradation. All these factors often interact, amplifying yield losses and complicating management strategies.

Expanding the symposium's scope will foster a more **integrated approach** to sunflower resilience, bringing together expertise in sunflower breeding and production, pest management, disease resistance and adaptation to environmental stresses.




